### **Getting Started**

**GOAL:** Assist MICMT in introducing and expanding team based MAT processes. Serve as the amplification method for MAT support within physician organization (PO).

#### **NOW**

- Determine practice eligibility
  - Does the practice have waived providers?
  - Does this practice have a care team?
  - Is this practice actively prescribing MAT?
    - If so, this practice probably does not need support
    - Remind practice of VBR opportunities

#### **BETWEEN MARCH 12 AND APRIL 29, 2020**

- Arrange time to shadow waived provider in clinic
  - Observe workflow
  - Observe available resources
  - Observe care team/patient interaction
  - Observe patient/provider interaction
- Based on observations, create an example workflow knowing there are many right ways to do this. Include roles of available care team members

#### **EARLY MAY, 2020 THROUGH AUGUST, 2020**

- Schedule introductory meetings at PO or practices
  - Introductory slide deck will be provided
  - Suggested length of time is 20 – 30 minutes
  - Suggested audience is care team members from practices with waived provider that are interested in beginning MAT care
- In May, participate in a virtual meeting with MICMT regarding outreach progress
