2022 BCBSM PDCM Training

Required Training

All care team members new to BCBSM PDCM must attend the Introduction to Team-Based Care course and view the BCBSM billing webinar.

The course covers the critical components of getting started as a care team member.

Continuing (Longitudinal) Education

Every learner has to accomplish (8) credit hours of additional training per year. These (8) credits may include:

- Official continuing education credits for licensure
- Approved PO-hosted meetings
- Webinars/learnings on the MICMT website
- Approved other courses







2022 Specialist Team-Based Care Training

Applies only to those care team members participating in the BCBSM Specialist Team-Based Care VBR Program, which is open to Oncology, Pulmonology, Cardiology, Endocrinology, and Nephrology. Describes the program and strategies for success.

New Care Team Members

All care team members new to the role must attend the *Introduction* to *Team-Based Care* course and view the *Specialist Team-Based*Care recorded webinar.

Experienced Care Team Members

Care team members with at least one year of experience in the role should watch the <u>Specialist Team-Based Care</u> recorded webinar.

PO representative fills out the survey describing the course
