#### **2023 BCBSM PDCM Training**

#### **Required Training**

All care team members new to BCBSM PDCM must attend the Introduction to Team-Based Care course and view the BCBSM billing webinar.

The course covers the critical components of getting started as a care team member.

#### **Continuing (Longitudinal) Education**

Every learner has to accomplish (8) credit hours of additional training per year.

These (8) credits may include:

- Official continuing education credits for licensure
- Approved PO-hosted meetings
- Webinars/learnings on the MICMT website
- Approved other courses







## **2023 Specialist Team-Based Care Training**

Applies only to those care team members participating in the BCBSM Specialist Team-Based Care VBR Program, which is open to Oncology, Pulmonology, Cardiology, Endocrinology, and Nephrology. Describes the program and strategies for success.

#### **New Care Team Members**

All care team members new to the role must attend the *Introduction* to *Team-Based Care* course and view the *Specialist Team-Based*Care recorded webinar.

#### **Experienced Care Team Members**

Care team members with at least one year of experience in the role should watch the <u>Specialist Team-Based Care</u> recorded webinar.

#### **Continuing (Longitudinal) Education**

Every learner has to accomplish (8) credit hours of additional training per year.

These (8) credits may include:

- 1. Official continuing education credits for licensure
- 2. Approved PO-hosted meetings
- Webinars/learnings on the MICMT website
- 4. Approved other courses

Describe what care team members need to know focusing on care management codes, billing optimization, application and clinical documentation

#### Introduction to Palliative Care

#### **Training Goal**

To create a foundation for introducing palliative care into the primary care setting earlier in the course of serious illness.

Longitudinal Credits

8

Training Reimbursement \$500 per completion of full-day \$250 per half-day





#### **Collaborative Care Model**

- Trainings are limited to those participating in the BCBSM Psychiatric Consult Collaborative Care Management Model (CoCM)
- Two partners—<u>MCCIST</u> and <u>MI-CCSI</u>—conduct all of the training
  - POs are assigned to one of the training partners
  - PO training partner assignments are available on the MICMT website
