

## Overview - MICMT Complex Care Management (CCM) Course Trainer Organization Application

**Who:** Physician Organizations and existing Trainer Organizations who would like to be an MICMT approved CCM Trainer organization are invited to submit an application.

- CCM course Statewide Trainer Organization requirements and Lead Trainer qualifications may be accessed on the MICMT CCM Statewide [Trainer webpage](#).
- A PO or existing trainer organization Manager or delegate reviews the application key documents and completes the web based application.

**What:** The MICMT application is web based and will be used to understand whether or not a specific training program may be approved as meeting training criteria for Michigan payer programs.

- This extends to BCBSM PDCM program, Priority Health Care Management Program and the MDHHS State Innovation Model (SIM) Patient Centered Medical Home (PCMH) Initiative.
- MDHHS recognizes the MICMT approved CCM courses as meeting the SIM PCMH Initiative Care Manager and Coordinator initial training requirements.
- The web based application requests information about the PO/Existing Trainer Organization and the CCM Statewide Lead Trainer candidate.

**When:** Statewide CCM Trainer Organization application opens on 6/10 and will remain open.

### Background/Additional information:

- Sources for the MICMT CCM course going forward include:
  - MICMT approved CCM PO /or existing Training Entity,
  - MICMT continues to offer the CCM course
  - If a PO decides to become an MICMT approved CCM course trainer and offers the course to non-affiliated practices, the PO may charge for the course.
  - If a PO decides to not be an MICMT approved CCM course trainer, they may select an MICMT approved CCM course or take the CCM course offered by the MICMT team. There is no fee for the MICMT CCM course.

- Standardized CCM course content: POs are encouraged to add content to the standardized CCM course content to tailor the information which is specific for their practices. For ex. Risk stratification – the PO can teach the steps used for risk stratification in the practice.
